“The Life and Works of Earl Young,
Charlevoix’s Master Builder in Stone”

This 1 hour, 45 minute fully narrated disc traces Earl Young’s life from his arrival in Charlevoix as an eleven-year-old in 1900 to his passing in 1975. It documents the development of his artistic vision, beginning in 1918, that created just over thirty unique stone structures now known around the world. Over 400 images, including vintage photos taken by Earl himself early in the 19th century, plus video shot exclusively for this DVD tell the story of how this determined, highly imaginative man transformed the landscape of Charlevoix. Particular emphasis is given to the near loss of the Weathervane Inn restaurant building, his masterpiece, due to channel erosion in the early 1970s, and how it was saved.
